



Our 2026–28 Residency at the Apollo Victoria Theatre, Harlem beginning *January 19, 2026*, with the Harlem Boys Choir Revival Auditions on **Martin Luther King Jr.** day. Harlem Collective launches its landmark two-year residency at the Apollo Victoria, each month celebrates Harlem's living legacy of music, faith, and artistry through three resident ensembles.

Rooted in Harlem's artistic legacy, the season truly kicks off during **Black History Month** and expands beyond the stage with *African Healing Sound Baths* in partnership with Harlem Hospitals, *Educational Matinee Outreach* for students and seniors, and *Midnight Spoken Word sessions* that honor Harlem's poetic tradition. Our ecosystem connects creativity and community through three signature brands:

Mais Soufflé Gourmet Popcorn, which helps raise funds for arts and education;

The Morning Show NYC, which keeps audiences engaged and informed Monday through Friday; and

Mood Magazine, the official playbill and cultural guide to Harlem's creative season — available in both digital and print editions.

Together, these brands sustain our mission to inspire peace, unity, and opportunity through art — right here in the heart of Harlem.
